

Acceptable raster image files with all text turned to curves or outlines at 100% / 300 dpi = .psd, .cpt, .tif, or .pdf

Acceptable vector image files with all text and outlines turned to curves or outlined at 100% = .ai, .cdr, .eps, or .svg

If you’re submitting images created in a raster image program like Adobe Photosop or Corel Photo-Paint, the resolution of the images you submit, should be no less than 300 dpi, with your document size. or artwork size, being the same as the template sizes we’ve provided, and saved as .psd, .cpt, or .pdf.

You may also submit images created in a vector program such as Adobe Illustrator or Corel Draw, and saved as .ai, .cdr., .eps, or .svg.

If submitting images created in Canva, make sure you’ve used the highest resolution print option, which is PDF Print Format at 300 DPI. Similarly, make sure you’ve started with a document size, the same as the template you’re designing for.

Do not use images such as .jpg or .png, as these can default to 96 DPI, which will result in a poor quality print product.

Lastly, make sure to render text, or convert to curves or outlines.
